

Guidance for Church members regarding new Safeguarding rules.

To enable a hirer of our Church Hall to comply with their safeguarding responsibility not to allow unknown adults access to children, young people and 'at risk' adults, all church members should be made aware that they **must not** (except in the case of an emergency) enter the space the hirer is using whilst the activity is taking place without prior agreement. The hirer is not aware of which church members are 'trusted' adults that have been safely recruited and may not have sufficient 'staff' to supervise both visitors and the children, young people and/or 'at risk' adults simultaneously. Thank you.
